
Master Circular - Network Connectivity

In terms of provisions of the Rules, Bye-Laws and Business Rules of the Exchange and in continuation to Exchange Circular No.: MCX/TECH/460/2017 dated December 14, 2017, Members of the Exchange are notified as under:

The Exchange has been issuing various circulars from time to time for various modes of connectivity such as Leased Line, Point to Point (P to P) Leased Line, Multi-Protocol Labeled Switching (MPLS) Leased Line and Internet and for accessing the on-line trading system. In order to provide users easy access to all the applicable circulars at one place, the Master Circular for Network Connectivity was issued in the year 2017 and the same is updated considering the circulars issued within years and additional information. This updated Master Circular is revision to earlier master circular after consolidating regulations / directions of all earlier circulars issued by Exchange from time to time.

In case of any inconsistency between the Master Circular and the applicable circulars, the content of the relevant circular shall prevail.

Notwithstanding in any revision in the processes or formats, if any-

- a) anything done or any action taken or purported to have been done or taken under such revised/ rescinded process including but not limited to any regulatory inspection/ investigation or enquiry commenced or any disciplinary proceeding initiated or to be initiated under such rescinded/ revised process or rescission, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of this Master Circular.
- b) the previous operation of the rescinded process or circular or anything duly done or suffered thereunder, any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred thereunder, any penalty incurred in respect of any violation of such rescinded process or circulars, or any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty as aforesaid, shall remain unaffected as if the rescinded process or circulars have never been rescinded.

Members may kindly take note and ensure compliance. The list of earlier circulars pertaining to Network connectivity is listed in annexure for reference purpose.

1 Various modes of Connectivity

Exchange has built trading infrastructure in Exchange Square, Mumbai, Maharashtra that is known as Primary Site (PS) and GIFT City, Gandhinagar, Gujarat known as Disaster Recovery Site (DRS)

MCX technology infrastructure is the foundation of our business and a key factor in the Exchange's development. The Exchange's online trading platform is accessible to our members through our trader workstation or computer-to-computer link ("CTCL") using multiple connectivity media including, Leased lines – Point to Point, MPLS (wired or wireless last mile connectivity), and the Internet.

The Exchange remains neutral with respect to selection of Service Provider. Wherever, Member wishes to apply through Exchange, the same shall be provided with best effort basis; in few cases, Service provider may not be able to provide connectivity as their infrastructure may not be feasible at Member office or there could be techno-commercial reason.

Members of the Exchange may choose any mode of connectivity and service provider(s) suitable to their business needs and requirements and make application(s) to the Exchange. Alternate modes of connectivity with details of bandwidth, charges, service providers and application procedure.

The Exchange strongly recommends that Members are required to avail connectivity from two different service providers for better uptime of connectivity & Business Continuity.

Following Network Connectivity is introduced by the Exchange and Member can choose the connectivity as per their business requirements:

1.1 Point to Point (P2P) Leased Line

Point-to-Point (P2P) connection refers to communication between two nodes or endpoints. The Exchange allows Point-to-Point Leased Line connectivity up to 100 Mbps i.e. (2/10/20/30/40/45/75/100 Mbps).

Member can avail Point to Point (P2P) leased line facility by submitting application for availing connectivity either through Exchange or by applying direct to exchange empaneled Service Providers. Members may please note that transfer of connectivity between Exchange & direct to service provider or vice versa is not permitted.

1.1.1 Option 1 – Avail Point-to-Point leased line through Exchange-

1.2 MPLS Leased Line

MPLS (Multi-Protocol Label Switching) is a mechanism in high-performance telecommunications network that directs data from one network to the next based on shortest path labels rather than long network addresses. MPLS can provide secure, cost effective, scalable, and managed end-to-end network connectivity. The Exchange allows MPLS Leased Line connectivity upto 40 Mbps, i.e. (2/10/20/30/40 Mbps).

Member can avail MPLS wired or wireless last mile leased line facility by submitting application for availing connectivity through Exchange.

1.2.1 Avail MPLS leased line through Exchange.

1.3 Internet

Internet is the global system of interconnected computer networks; Member can avail the Internet connectivity directly from the respective Service Provider.

The Exchange has introduced RSA Hardware Token and SSL-VPN (secure socket layer) for users trading over Internet. RSA is a two-factor authentication (T-FA) to provide better and secure mode of connectivity for trading. T-FA is implemented using RSA Secure ID hardware token from RSA.

2 Network Connectivity Procedure - For Point to Point and MPLS Leased Line

2.1 Application and Feasibility

2.1.1 Option 1 Avail Point-to-Point / MPLS leased line through Exchange.

Members desirous of availing facility of 2/10/20/30/40/45/75/100 Mbps P2P and 2/10/20/30/40 Mbps MPLS (wired or wireless last mile) Leased Line connectivity through Exchange is required to send feasibility request over email to MCX-LeasedLine@mcxindia.com as per [Network Connectivity Form](#).

On receipt of the said e-mail, Exchange shall process feasibility of the location from the service provider/s as per the choice indicated by the member. Thereafter feasibility details will be intimated to the member through email for obtaining confirmation to

process further. Validity of the feasibility declared by the respective service provider is 15 days, thereafter member is required to do re-feasibility.

After receipt of the feasibility details from the Exchange, members are required to submit duly filled and signed undertaking as per [Network Connectivity Undertaking-Leased Line](#) to the Membership department.

2.1.2 Option 2 Avail P2P leased line directly from Service Provider.

Members desirous of availing connectivity directly from the Service Provider, need to submit the application over email to MCX-LeasedLine@mcxindia.com for obtaining No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the Exchange. While applying directly to the service provider member is required to submit the undertaking as per [Network Connectivity Undertaking-Leased Line](#).

Thereafter, Exchange will process the application for Point to Point or MPLS leased line connectivity through the respective service provider.

2.2 Commercials for Point-to-Point Leased Line

2.2.1 Option 1 Avail Point to Point Leased Line through Exchange

Note 1: The above-said charges are applicable for Mumbai region only. The charges for the links applied out of the Mumbai region will be as per actuals.

The above-mentioned charges are exclusive of any government taxes, duties and levies and the same are to be paid extra by members.

Payment Terms:

- For the first financial year, the annual charges are to be paid in advance for the first year from the date of leased line commissioning.
- For the second financial year, the annual charges shall be calculated on a pro-rata basis from completion of first year till March 31st.
- For the third financial year and their onwards, the annual charges shall be payable in advance.

2.2.2 Option -2 Last mile charges for Private Point to Point Leased Line

Members are required to pay last mile charges (OTC and ARC) directly to service provider in case the point-to-point leased line is obtained directly from service provider.

2.2.3 Port Charges to Exchange applicable for both the P2P leased line options

The above-mentioned charges are exclusive of any government taxes, duties and levies and the same are to be paid extra by members.
The Port Charges are Non-Refundable.

Payment Terms:

- For the first financial year, the advance annual charges shall be calculated on a pro-rata basis from the date of leased line commissioning till March 31st.
- For the second financial year and their onwards, the annual charges shall be payable in advance.

The above-mentioned charges are exclusive of any government taxes, duties and levies and the same are to be paid extra by members.

* **Turn Around Time (TAT)** – To provision the MPLS leased line without router is 6 weeks and with bundle Router is 2-3 months from the date of application.

****Charges to Exchange** – No charges are applied by Exchange for MPLS Leased Line Connectivity.

Payment Terms:

- For the first financial year, the annual charges are to be paid in advance for the first year from the date of leased line commissioning.
- For the second financial year, the annual charges shall be calculated on a pro-rata basis from completion of the first year till March 31st.
- For the third financial year and their onwards, the annual charges shall be payable in advance.

2.4 Upgrading Leased line connectivity

Members desirous of upgrading a Leased line connectivity obtained from Exchange, are required to submit duly signed application as per the [Network Connectivity Form](#) to Membership department. The charges for upgrading the leased line would be charged on pro-rata basis as per the charges confirmed by service provider. On receipt of the demand note / invoice from the respective service provider, Exchange would inform member about the additional charges applicable for the upgrade. If the Upgradation of leased line connectivity is not feasible at the location, the same will be intimated to the member through email.

In case of connectivity is taken directly from the service provider, Member needs to inform Exchange regarding upgrading of the connectivity through email MCX-LeasedLine@mcxindia.com for record and user ID mapping.

2.5 Shifting of Leased line connectivity

Members desirous of shifting MPLS or Point to Point leased line connectivity are required to e-mail the new location details to MCX-LeasedLine@mcxindia.com as per [Network Connectivity Form](#). If the shifting of leased line connectivity is feasible at new location, the same will be intimated to the member. Thereafter members should submit duly signed application as per the [Network Connectivity Form](#) to MCX membership department. Shifting charges will be debited after completion of shifting of the connectivity from the settlement account of their respective Clearing Member based on [Network Connectivity Form](#) submitted by Member to the Exchange.

2.5.1 Commercials and criteria for shifting of Leased Line

The above-mentioned charges are exclusive of any government taxes, duties and levies and the same are to be paid extra by members.

- In case of Point-to-Point leased line connectivity directly applied to service provider then Member needs to inform Exchange for change of Installation address via email MCX-LeasedLine@mcxindia.com for record.

2.6 Surrendering of Leased line connectivity

Members desirous of surrendering network connectivity are required to submit duly signed application as per the [Network Connectivity Form](#) to MCX membership department.

- Members are not entitled to a refund of any Annual Recurring Charges (ARC) if the network connectivity is surrendered within a year of installation. From the second year onwards, members will be entitled to get refund of pro-rata annual recurring charges from service provider for the unexpired portion of that year. The un-expired portion shall constitute the period after completion of 30 days for Airtel and 45 days for TCL from the date of submission of surrender application to service provider.
- The applicable refund amount will be credited to member's settlement account as and when the same is received by the Exchange from the respective service provider.
- Members are requested to note that Port Charges will not be refunded with respect to financial year for which the same have been recovered, even if the leased lines are surrendered/cancelled prior to end of such financial year.
- Contract Period for all the links are as follows,
 - a) Links without Router is 1 year.
 - b) Links with Router is 2 years.
- In case of early Termination of MPLS Links procured with routers will attract charges of 50% of ARC for the remaining term as Early Termination Charges after minimum term period of 1 year from the date of commissioning.
- Any links that are terminated before the contract term will attract 100% of ARC as Early Termination Charges (ETC).

The Exchange shall process the application on receipt of complete documents as prescribed and after verifying the dues if any and related compliance formalities.

Important Note:

- a) Members who are using only Point to point Leased circuit(s) to connect to the primary site of the Exchange are advised to obtain separate connectivity to the MCX Disaster Recovery Site (DRS) at Gift City to participate in Mock Trading or live trading from DRS site.
- b) It is recommended that Members are required to avail connectivity from two different service providers for redundancy and uptime of network connectivity & business continuity.
- c) MPLS Wireless last mile connectivity will be provided to members, only in case of non-feasibility of wireline connectivity.
- d) Network feasibility at member's location is at the discretion of the service provider chosen by the member.
- e) Network latency may vary depending upon the mode of connectivity and the geographical distance between Member's trading location and the Exchange.
- f) Exchange has always put best efforts to deliver any network connectivity at the earliest. However considering dependency on service provider, turnaround time for feasibility check is 1 week, for application process and connectivity delivery is 6 weeks (without Router) and 2-3 months (with Router).
- g) Upon surrendering the network connectivity, members are required to return all applicable network termination equipment owned by the service provider to ensure no commercial implications.

- h) The minimum pre-requisite for installation of **MPLS** wireless connectivity is as below:
1. Space with Air-Cooled/Dust-Free environment for networking devices.
 2. Building Permission and secured space for Pole/Tower installation at building roof top.
 3. Stabilized Uninterrupted Power supply 24x7 with earthing of $E/N \leq 3V$
 4. Stable and uninterrupted power supply, 2x6 amp Power Sockets
 5. Inbuilding cable shaft (If available) for cable safety from roof top pole to indoor unit
 6. Members will have to ensure the physical safety of networking devices installed by service provider. Charges will be applicable in case of any physical damage to devices.
- i) Members are requested to note that the Exchange is only facilitator between the members and service providers for establishing connectivity to the Exchange trading platform. MCX is not responsible or liable for any loss or damage etc. suffer due to any delay, disturbance, or non-availability of connectivity or due to any reason because of service provider / network integrator or otherwise.

3 RSA Token for Internet Connectivity

- Introduction**

The Exchange has introduced RSA Hardware Token for users trading over Internet which is a two-factor authentication (T-FA) to provide better and secure mode of connectivity for trading. T-FA is implemented using RSA Secure ID Software token from RSA, one of the premier providers of security solutions.

RSA Secure ID two-factor authentication comprises of a password or PIN (the first factor) and an authenticator (the token which is the second factor) provides reliable and secured user authentication. Hence for login to the system user needs to key in the username & password and the one-time password (OTP) generated by the RSA token which changes every minute. Only after providing the correct username-password along with a valid OTP the user will be allowed to login for trading.

- Applicable Users**

Members, who are trading over the Internet, essentially need to procure RSA Software token for two factor authentication for better and secure mode of connectivity.

- Mode of Delivery of RSA Token**

The Exchange provides RSA software token & applicable RSA Manual to its members via email. Users need to follow instructions given in the manual for usage of RSA token.

- Charges for RSA Token**

The RSA Software token shall be valid to the expiry date shown in RSA secure Id Application and thereafter the Exchange will issue fresh new RSA Hardware Token to the members on the basis of email confirmation by the Member.

- Procedure for usage of RSA Token**

Users must send requests through UIMS portal for mapping the user ID on internet. After mapping the user ID on internet Member must send request to customer support team (customersupport@mcxindia.com) for requirement of RSA token in the following format.

Software RSA token is issued in three version Desktop, Android version (mobile) and IOS Mobile. Member has to choose one version.

Member can apply for RSA token with preference to install on

- 1) Desktop/laptop
- 2) Android mobile
- 3) IOS mobile

After issuing the RSA Token to applicable users, the Exchange flashes message on the Trading Terminal for start usage of RSA Token for two factor authentication for trading through Internet.

RSA Software token once issued to a user cannot be used by any other user. However, when a user becomes inactive, the RSA Software token can be re-validated for another user without any charge.

Renewal of RSA token: - Before expiry date of the token MCX will issue the new RSA token after receiving written e-mail confirmation from member. The applicable charge will be deducted from member settlement account after delivery of the software RSA token.

Re-Validation of RSA token: Whenever user becomes inactive from internet, the RSA Software token mapped to that user can be re-validated for another user. The re-validated token can be used till the end of its validity period.

Conversion of RSA Token: Member can change the preference of RSA token from Desktop to Android and vice versa.

6. I /we agree that I / we shall pay the cancellation charges and other expenses incurred to establish the Leased Line as requested by me / us that may become payable, in the event of cancellation of the application / closure of the Leased line at a later date.

For the purposes of this Clause, "Force Majeure" means and includes wars, insurrections, revolution, fires, floods, epidemic, quarantine restrictions, declared general strikes in relevant industries, act of God, act of the Government of India and any concerned State Government and such other acts or events beyond MCX's control and further the above is without prejudice to the rights already accrued to MCX due to my/our failure to perform either in full or in part, my/our obligations prior to the occurrence of events of Force Majeure.
12. I / We shall not hold MCX responsible or liable for any loss, damage, etc., suffered due to any delay, disturbance or non-availability of connectivity or due to any reason because of Service Provider /Network Integrator or otherwise, at any time including the reasons stated in Force Majeure clause hereinabove.
13. I / We shall indemnify and keep indemnified MCX harmless against every and all claims, demands, damages, liabilities, losses and expenses, etc., suffered by it directly by reason of my / our non-compliance, contravention with any of the

provisions of this Undertaking or any penalty imposed by Service Provider /Network Integrator or DOT /Regulatory or statutory Authorities, due to my/ our non-compliances or violation of any provisions of the applicable Act(s) or Rules and Regulations in force.

14. I / We agree that no forbearance, delay or indulgence by MCX in enforcing the provisions of this Undertaking shall prejudice or restrict the rights of MCX nor shall any waiver of its rights operate as a waiver of any subsequent breach and no rights, powers, remedies herein conferred upon or reserved for MCX is exclusive of any other right, power or remedy available to MCX and each right, power or remedy shall be cumulative.

15. I/ We hereby undertake and agree that this Undertaking-cum-Indemnity shall be valid and effective for any leased line(s) obtained by the undersigned for connecting to MCX, from time to time. Further, this Undertaking-cum-Indemnity does not lapse till such time, the Exchange discharges the undersigned.

16. That I / we shall execute, sign and subscribe to such other documents, papers, agreement, covenants, bonds, and/or undertakings as may be prescribed or required by MCX from time to time.

17. I/We also agree that in the event of my/our non-compliance with any of the provisions as mentioned above, MCX shall take such action(s) against us as it may deem fit in this regard.
